Dr Ernesto Sirolli

Passion, entrepreneurship, and the rebirth of local economies

Dr Sirolli has an international reputation for his person-centred model for regional economic development. Enterprise facilitation uses the passion of local people and resources of local networks to foster indigenous business ideas rather than importing large industry. It is a model that is particularly appropriate for rural and regional areas such as Tasmania and for working with disadvantaged population groups.

In 1985, he pioneered this approach in Esperance, a small rural community in Western Australia and the striking results have inspired more than 250 communities around the world.

Dr Sirolli's address will focus on the inter-connectedness of social justice and economic development initiatives and provide examples of where his model has been used to foster social enterprise.

Dr. Sirolli is a highly entertaining speaker and noted authority in the field of sustainable economic development, and is in demand as a speaker world-wide.
