**MAD Day** is part of the **ruMAD?** (Are You Making a Difference?) Program, which aims to develop student engagement in learning through social action.

**ruMAD?** is inquiry-based and values-focused and allows significant connections to be made to the Tasmanian Curriculum Framework.

#### **MAD Day**

- is a one-day activity that allows you to explore concepts of student action and awareness that can create positive change in the community.
- helps you identify your students' concerns, values and how they see their role in the community.
- is a day of action that empowers students to see and believe that they have the ability to Make A Difference.

#### **MAD Day** can be:

- A stand alone activity to raise awareness of student concerns;
- A day to launch a new MAD Project; or
- A day to acknowledge and celebrate past MAD projects.
